Du'aa on the Day of 'Arafat

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ ، وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ ، وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

The best of supplications is the supplication on the day of Aarafah and the best which I and the Prophets before me have said (is):

“None has the right to be worshipped except Allah, alone, without partner. To Him belongs sovereignty and all praise and He is over all things omnipotent.” *Sources: At-Tirmithi No# 3585*

Laa ilaaha ill-Allaahu, Waḥdahu laa Shareeka Lah, laahul-mulku wa laahul-ḥamdu, wa huwa 'alaa kulli shay'in qadeer

Takbeer

'Ali Radi-Allahu 'Anhu Used to recite Takbeer **at all times** in the First 13 days of Dhul-Hijjah **and specifically** he would recite **it after each prayer from Fajr of 9th of Dhul-Hijjah to Asr of 13th Dhul-Hijjah** (Takbir Al-Muqayyad). Hence it is recommended to say the Takbeer loudly after the prayer but the rest of the Adhkar quietly. The commonly used words of the Takbeer, as related from Umar and Ibn Mas'ud, are:

الله أكبر الله أكبر الله أكبر لا إله إلا الله
الله أكبر الله أكبر والله الحمد

Allah is Great, Allah is Great Allah is Great there is no God, but Allah
Allah is Great, Allah is Great to Him belongs all Praise

Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar Allahu Akbar La illaha il Allah
Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar WaLilahil Hamd
